

Sexual harassment

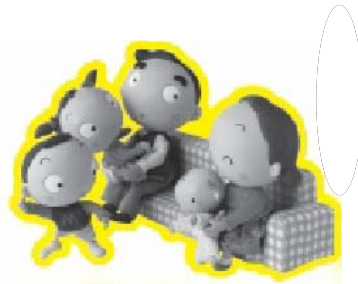
Anyone who threatens, cheats, or uses violence or other inappropriate methods to achieve the following commits sexual harassment:

- forces us to have sexual intercourse

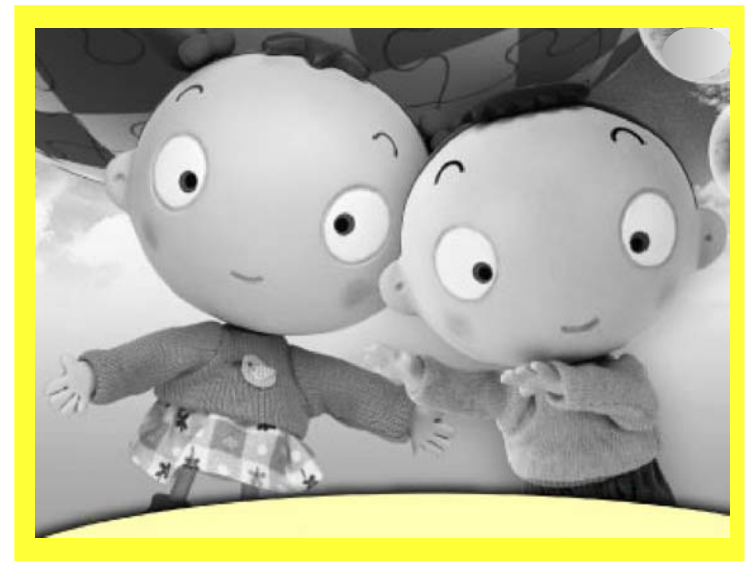

- If you have any queries about sexual harassment, seek help from an adult whom you trust as soon as possible.



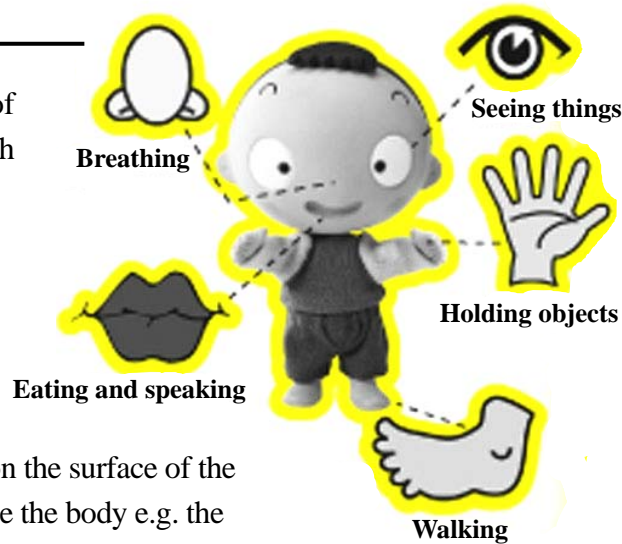

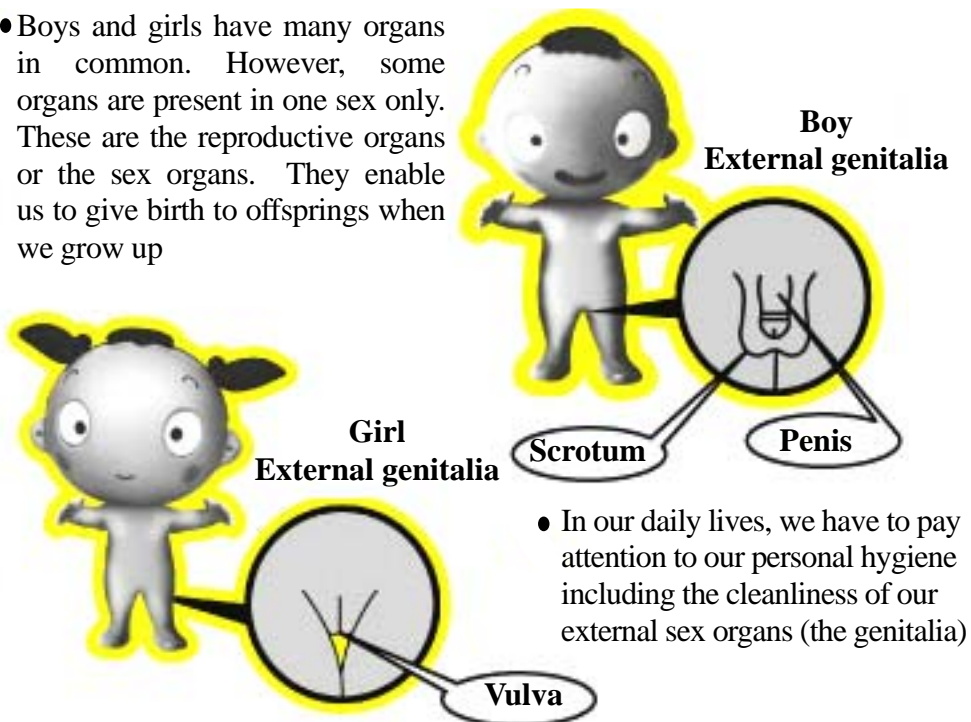
Know our body

- Our body is made up of different organs and each has its own functions



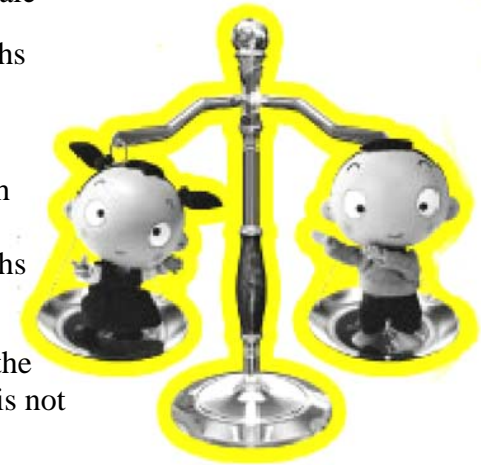
- Some organs are located on the surface of the body while some are inside the body e.g. the heart, lungs, kidneys, brain etc.

- Boys and girls have many organs in common. However, some organs are present in one sex only. These are the reproductive organs or the sex organs. They enable us to give birth to offsprings when we grow up



Sex and strength

- we are born as either male or female
